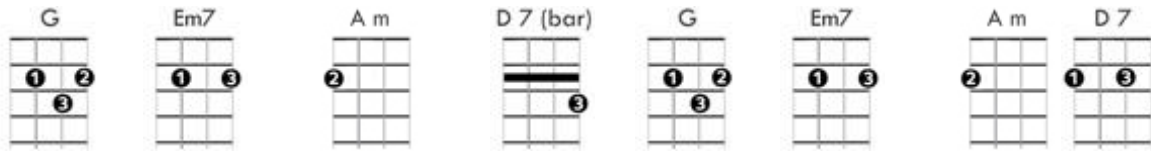


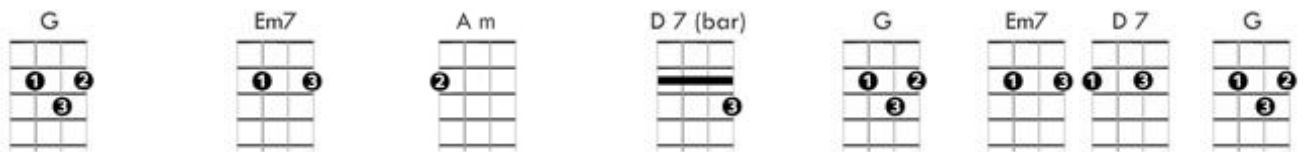
## Molly Malone – Soprano Ukulele

3. She died of a fever, and no one could save her, and that was the end of sweet Molly Malone

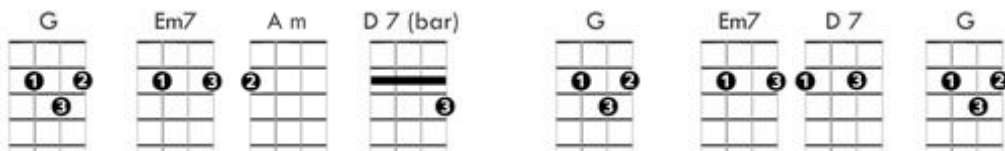


1. As she wheeled her wheel-barrow, through streets broad and narrow, Crying cockles and mussels, alive, alive - O!
